You don't need a budget, an organization or any special expertise. What matters is that you show up, start a conversation, and help the **Every Body** message travel further.



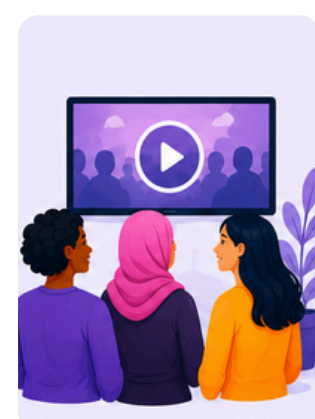
Host a conversation

Pick one of the five parts of the campaign and talk about it in your workplace, classroom, community or home. No expert needed. Just an honest, respectful conversation.



Run a workshop

Use the fact sheet and slide deck for a session with your team, class or group. Both work in any setting.



Screen a film or video

Choose a film or documentary that opens the subject, then talk about it afterward. Film starts conversations that are hard to start any other way.



Post online

Share what you are doing using #WSHD2026 and #EveryBody, so it connects to the global campaign.



Create something

Art, writing, music, photography. Bring Every Body into your community in whatever form works there.



Do something small

Share a fact. Raise a subject you would usually leave alone. Point someone toward a resource. Small things, done by a lot of people, are how this changes.
